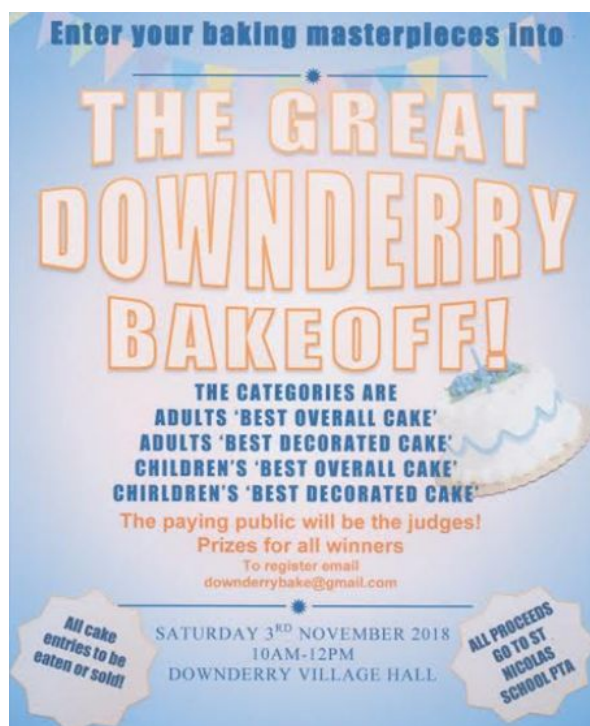
A Message from the P.T.A...
