**Role:** Qualified Teacher (Intervention Leader)

<b>Overall Purpose</b>	<b>To plan and deliver an appropriate, broad, balanced, relevant, differentiated and challenging curriculum to specific groups of pupils appropriate to their needs.</b>
<b>Professional Duties</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- To assess, record and report on all aspects of pupils' progress and development;</li> <li>- Contribute to raising standards of pupil attainment;</li> <li>- To provide or contribute to oral and written assessments relating to individual pupils or groups of pupils, internally, with parents and outside agencies;</li> <li>- To ensure high standards of behaviour so effective learning can take place, and good relationships can be formed within the school community</li> </ul>
<b>Professional Responsibilities</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- To play a full part in the life of the school community and support its ethos, values and aims;</li> <li>- To contribute to, follow and actively promote the agreed policies of the school and multi-academy trust;</li> <li>- To have high expectations and lead by example;</li> <li>- To contribute to the evaluation and monitoring of the school curriculum and to assist in the process of development and change to ensure the continuing relevance of policies and procedures to the needs of the pupils;</li> <li>- To work as a member of a team and to contribute positively to effective working relations within the school and multi-academy trust;</li> <li>- To have and share with colleagues a good, up to date working knowledge and understanding of how to use and adapt a range of teaching, learning and behaviour management strategies, including how to personalise the learning experience to provide opportunities for all learners to achieve their potential;</li> <li>- To comply with the Academy Trust Health and Safety policy and undertake risk assessments as appropriate;</li> <li>- To engage actively in Performance Management and Professional Development to ensure professional skills are developed and kept up to date;</li> <li>- To share and support the Academy Trust's responsibility to provide and monitor opportunities for academic and personal growth.</li> </ul>
